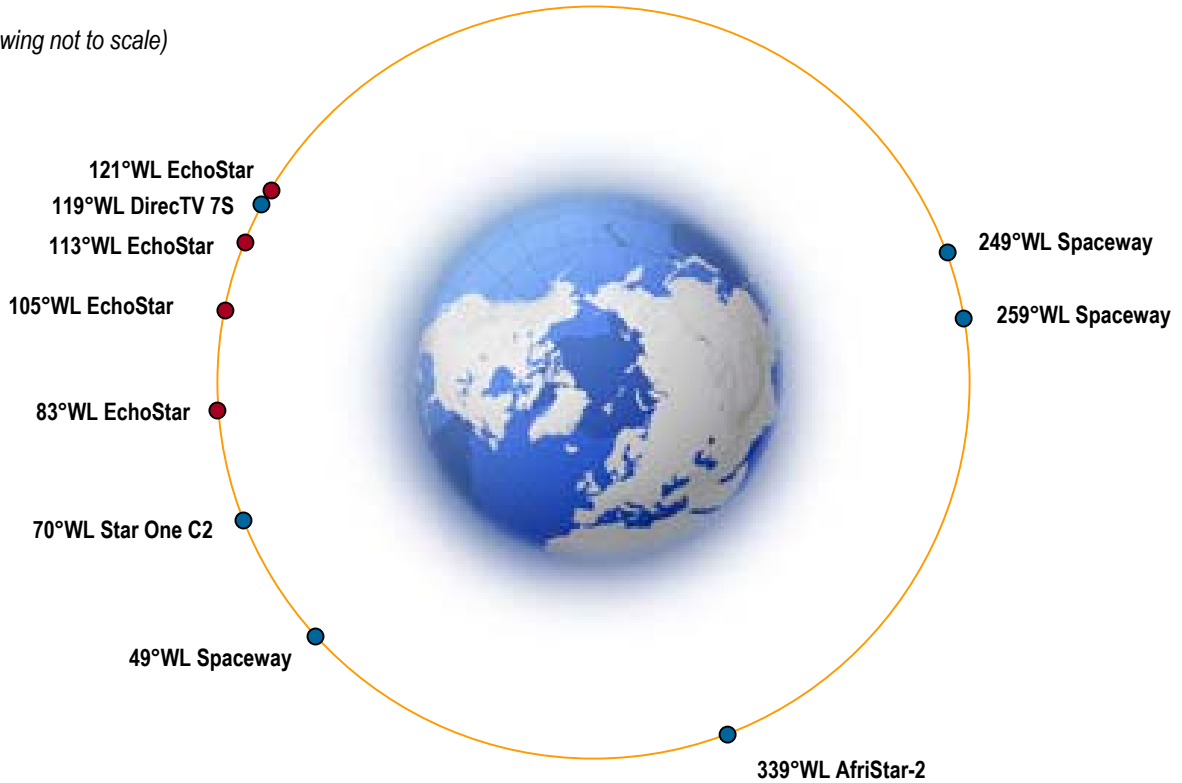


**Selected Satellites with

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for April 2004 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)		
Location	Satellite	Activity
49 WL, 249 WL, 259 WL	Spaceway	Hughes surrendered its Ka-band licenses for these orbital locations.
70 WL	Star One C2	Star One applied to add the Star One C2 satellite to the FCC's Permitted Space Station List at 70 WL.
83 WL, 121 WL	EchoStar	The FCC denied EchoStar's request to operate these satellites in the NGSO Ka-band frequencies.
105 WL, 113 WL	EchoStar	The FCC denied EchoStar's request to operate these satellites in the NGSO Ka-band and extended Ku-band frequencies.
119 WL	DirecTV 7S	The FCC granted DirecTV's request to launch and operate the DirecTV 7S satellite at 119 WL.
339 WL	AfriStar-2	AfriSpace applied to launch and operate the AfriStar-2 satellite to be co-located with AfriStar-1 at 339 WL (21 EL). The new satellite will launch in 2006.
