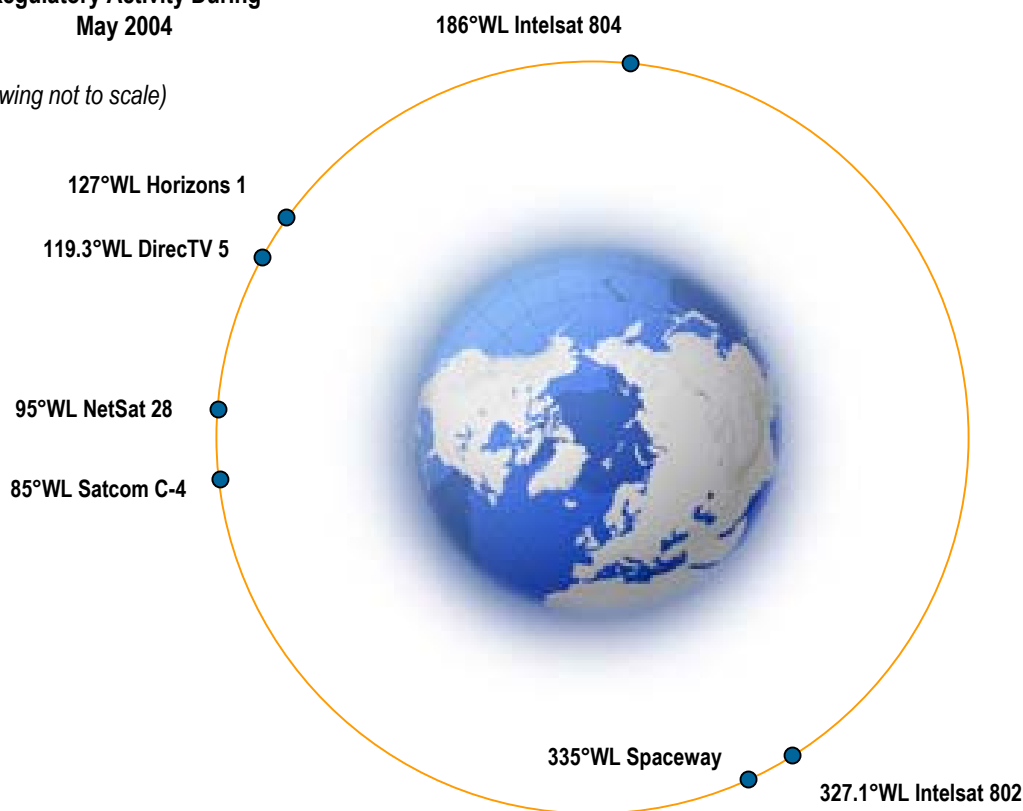




Futron Satellite Regulatory Report

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for May 2004 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)

Location	Satellite	Activity
85 WL	Satcom C-4	SES Americom filed this request to permanently relocate the Satcom C-4 satellite from 135 WL to 85 WL.
95 WL	NetSat 28	NetSat 28 applied to add a second Ka-band satellite to its licensed 95 WL orbital location.
119.3 WL	DirecTV 5	The FCC granted DirecTV's request to move the DirecTV 5 satellite from 119.2 WL to 119.3 WL to accommodate the arrival of the DirecTV 7S satellite at 119.2 WL.
127 WL	Horizons 1	The FCC granted Horizons' request to modify its Permitted Space Station List entry for the Horizons 1 satellite to allow Horizons 1 to provide one-way DTH services, including HDTV and local channel access, to the U.S.
186 WL	Intelsat 804	Intelsat applied to relocate the Intelsat 804 satellite in July 2004 from 184 WL (176 EL) to 186 WL (174 EL).
327.1 WL	Intelsat 802	Intelsat applied to move the Intelsat 802 satellite from 186 WL (174 EL) to 327.1 WL (32.9 EL).
335 WL	Spaceway	Hughes surrendered its Ka-band license for 335 WL (25 EL) on 5/19/04.
NGSO	Iridium	The FCC granted Iridium's request for an extension of authority to operate on the 1620.1-1621.35 MHz band (Channel 9) over the Middle East through 11/8/04.
