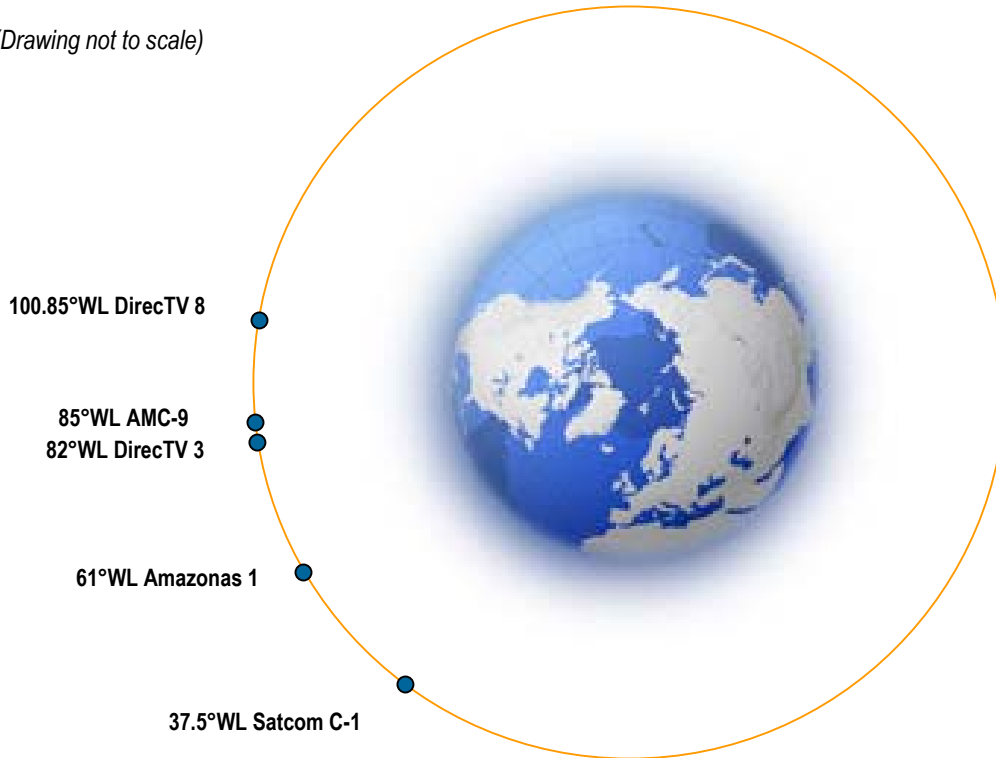


**Selected Satellites with

**Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for June 2004** (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)

Location	Satellite	Activity
37.5 WL	Satcom C-1	SES Americom applied to extend its operating license for Satcom C-1 through 12/17/04.
61 WL	Amazonas 1	The FCC added the Amazonas 1 satellite to the Permitted Space Station list at 61 WL.
82 WL	DirecTV 3	The FCC approved DirecTV's request to relocate the DirecTV 3 satellite from a storage orbit to 82 WL. DirecTV has agreed to lease all of the capacity of the DirecTV 3 satellite to Telesat Canada as backup for the failing Nimiq 2 satellite.
85 WL	AMC-9	The FCC approved permanent operation of the AMC-9 satellite at 85 WL.
100.85 WL	DirecTV 8	DirecTV applied to replace the DirecTV 2 satellite at 101 WL with the hybrid DBS/Ka-band DirecTV 8 satellite, which will launch in the spring of 2005.
