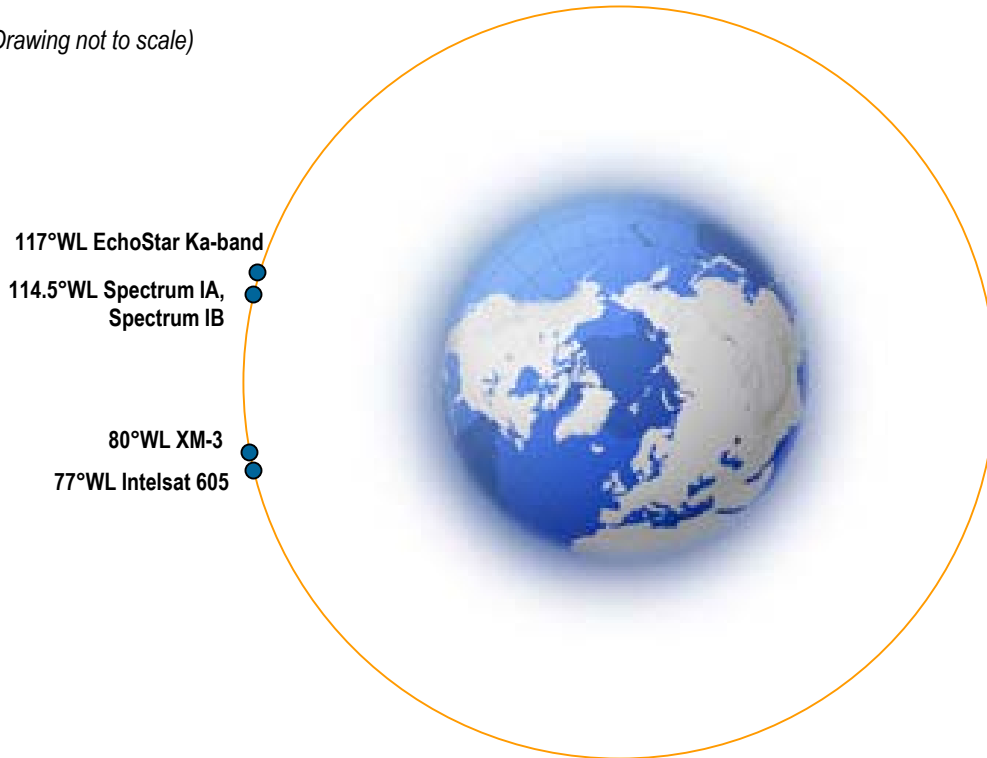


**Selected Satellites with

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for December 2004 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)

Location	Satellite	Activity
77 WL	Intelsat 605	The FCC granted Intelsat's request to operate the Intelsat 605 satellite at 77 WL for a period of 60 days to serve "commercial needs". The satellite will eventually be relocated to to 182 WL (178 EL).
80 WL	XM-3	XM filed this request to test its XM-3 satellite at 80 WL for a period of 60 days following its expected launch in the first quarter of 2005.
114.5 WL	Spectrum IA, Spectrum IB	Spectrum Five filed this request to provide DBS service to the United States via two "short-spaced" foreign-licensed satellites located at 114.5 WL.
117 WL	EchoStar Ka-band	The FCC granted EchoStar's request to modify its Ka-band authorization for 123 WL to utilize the 117 WL orbital location instead.
