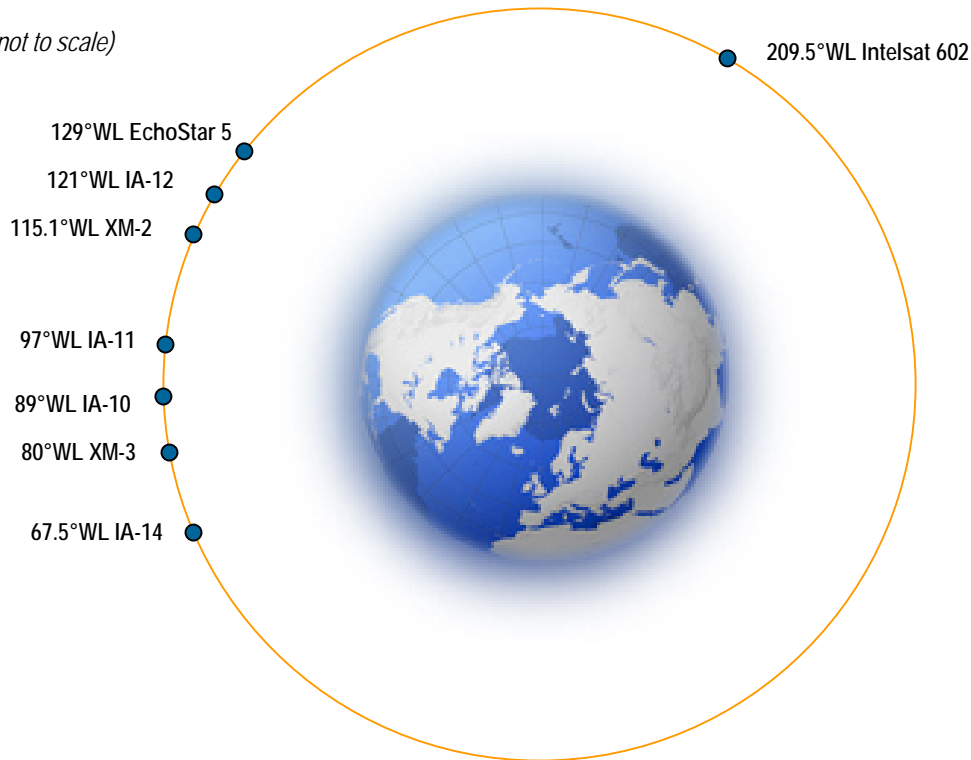


Selected Satellites with

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for February 2005 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)

Location	Satellite	Activity
67.5 WL, 89 WL, 97 WL, 121 WL	IA-14, IA-10, IA-11, IA-12	Intelsat applied to launch and operate four new Ka-band satellites: IA-14, at 67.5 WL; IA-10, at 89 WL; IA-11, at 97 WL; and IA-12, at 121 WL.
80 WL	XM-3	The FCC granted XM's request to test its XM-3 satellite at 80 WL for 60 days following launch.
115.1 WL	XM-2	XM applied to temporarily relocate the XM-2 satellite from 115 WL to 115.1 to accommodate the arrival of XM-1 at 115 WL.
129 WL	EchoStar 5	EchoStar applied to move EchoStar 5 from 119 WL to 129 WL where it will operate as a Canadian-licensed satellite.
209.5 WL	Intelsat 602	The FCC granted Intelsat's request to move the Intelsat 602 satellite from 309.5 WL (50.5 EL) to 209.5 WL (150.5 EL).
