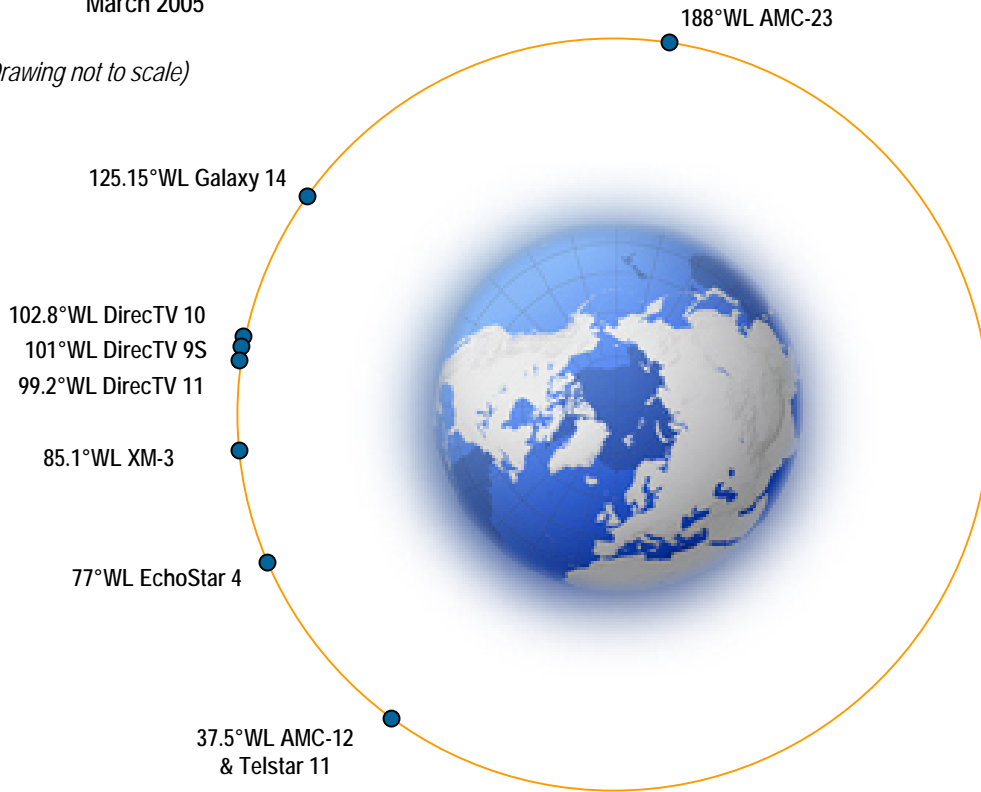


Selected Satellites with

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for March 2005 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)

Location	Satellite	Activity
37.45 WL	AMC-12	Columbia Communications applied to operate AMC-12 at 37.45 WL to simplify stationkeeping with Telstar 11 at 37.5 WL.
37.55 WL	Telstar 11	Loral Orion applied to operate Telstar 11 at 37.55 WL to simplify stationkeeping with AMC-12 at 37.5 WL.
77 WL	EchoStar 4	EchoStar applied to move EchoStar 4 from 157 WL to 77 WL, where it will be operated under a Mexican license by QuetzSat, a Mexican operator affiliated with SES Americom.
85.1 WL	XM-3	XM applied to operate XM-3 from 85.1 WL instead of 85 WL.
99.2 WL	DirecTV 11	The FCC granted DirecTV's request to launch and operate DirecTV 11 at 99.2 WL.
101 WL	DirecTV 9S	DirecTV applied to launch and operate DirecTV 9S at 101 WL as a replacement for DirecTV 1.
102.8 WL	DirecTV 10	The FCC granted DirecTV's request to launch and operate DirecTV 10 at 102.8 WL.
125.15 WL	Galaxy 14	The FCC granted PanAmSat's request to operate Galaxy 14 at 125.15 WL rather than 125.05 WL.
188 WL	AMC-23	The FCC granted SES Americom's request to launch and operate AMC-23, a replacement satellite for Satcom SN-4.
