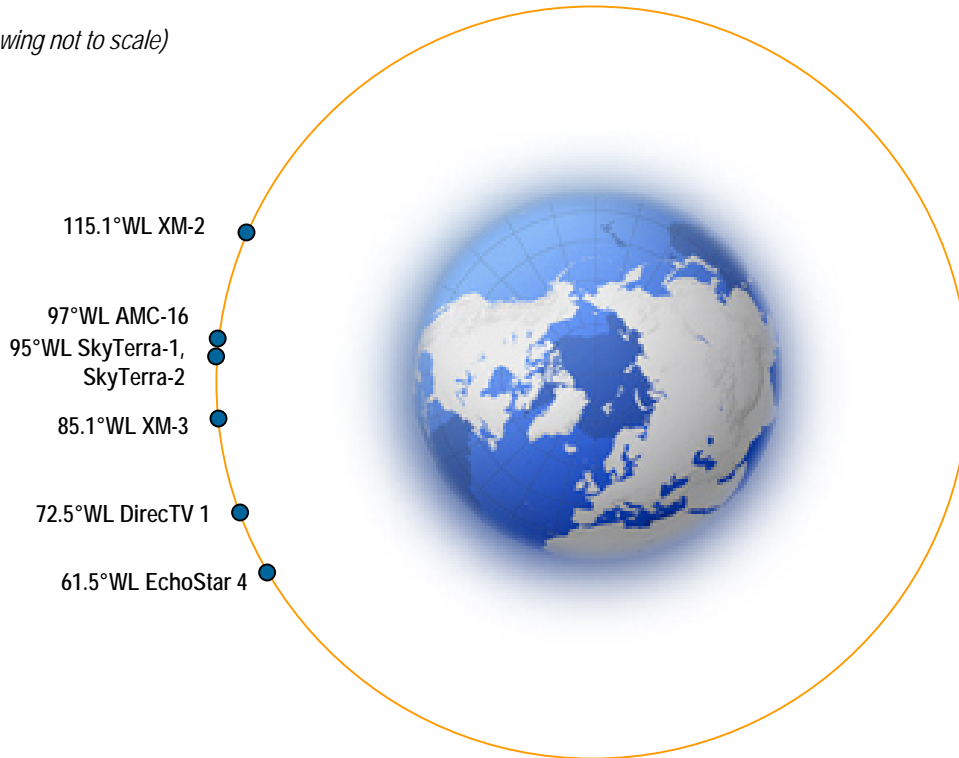


Selected Satellites with

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for April 2005 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)

Location	Satellite	Activity
61.5 WL	EchoStar 4	EchoStar applied to move EchoStar 4 from 157 WL to 61.5 WL. This move will bring the satellite closer to its intended destination of 77 WL, where it will be operated by QuetzSat.
72.5 WL	DirecTV 1	DirecTV requested authority to move DirecTV 1 to 72.5 WL to replace DirecTV 5, which will be relocated upon the arrival of DirecTV 1.
85.1 WL	XM-3	The FCC granted XM's request to operate XM-3 from 85.1 WL instead of 85 WL.
95 WL	SkyTerra-1, SkyTerra-2	The FCC granted SkyTerra's request to launch and operate two Ka-band satellites at 95 WL to provide local-into-local DTH, HDTV programming, on-demand entertainment, digital music, as well as interactive television and high-speed Internet access.
97 WL	AMC-16	The FCC granted SES Americom's request to operate AMC-16 at 97 WL for two months.
115.1 WL	XM-2	The FCC granted XM's request to temporarily relocate the XM-2 satellite from 115 WL to 115.1 to accommodate the arrival of XM-1 at 115 WL.
