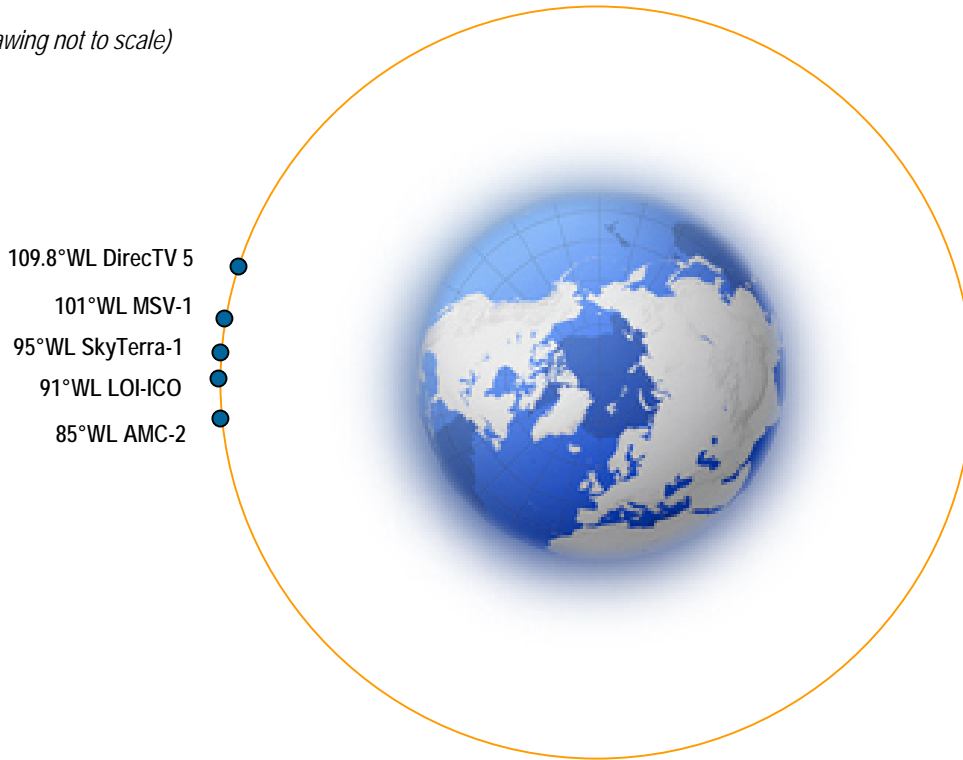


Selected Satellites with

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for May 2005 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)		
Location	Satellite	Activity
85 WL	AMC-2	SES Americom applied to move the AMC-2 satellite from 105 WL to 85 WL.
91 WL	LOI-ICO	The FCC granted ICO's request to launch one GEO satellite to 91 WL instead of a multi-satellite NGSO constellation to fulfill its 2 GHz MSS license.
95 WL	SkyTerra-1	SkyTerra applied to combine its two Ka-band authorizations at 95 WL into a single authorization.
101 WL	MSV-1	The FCC approved MSV's request to launch and operate its next-generation L-band MSS satellite, MSV-1, at 101 WL.
109.8 WL	DirecTV 5	DirecTV to "reflag" DirecTV 5 as a U.S. satellite and move it from 72.5 WL to 109.8 WL where it will replace the failing DirecTV 6 satellite. DirecTV 5 has been operating as a Canadian satellite since September 2004.
