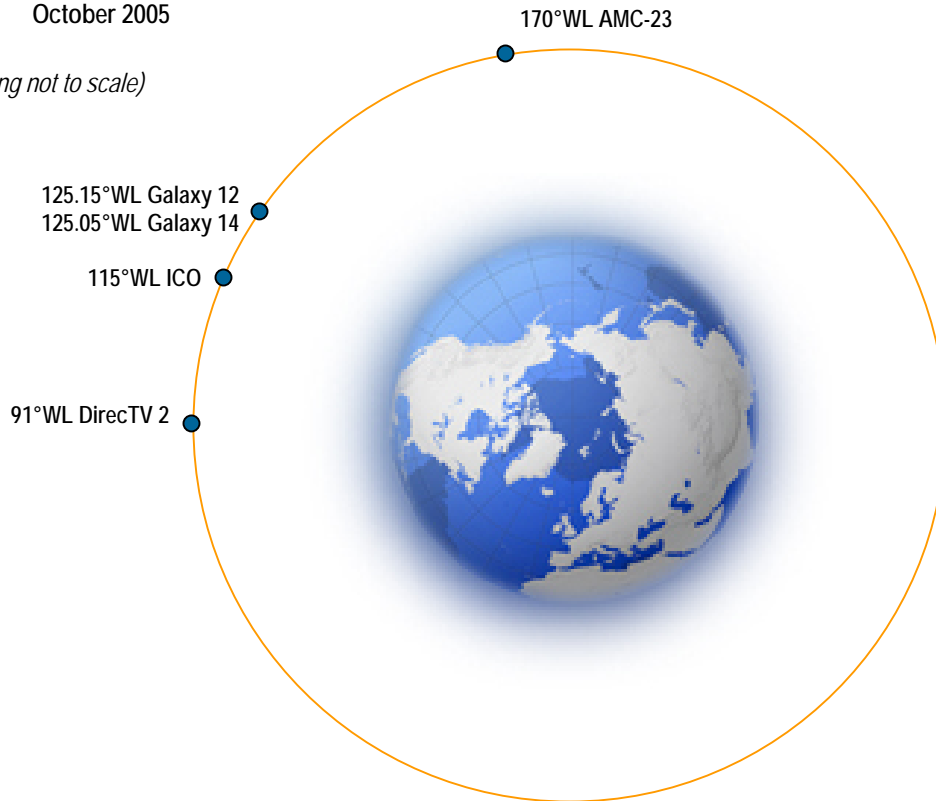


Selected Satellites with

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for October 2005 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)

Location	Satellite	Activity
91 WL	DirecTV 2	DirecTV applied to move the DirecTV 2 satellite from 100.6 WL to the Canadian BSS slot at 91 WL, where it will be operated by Telesat Canada through a license from the Canadian government.
115 WL	ICO	ICO applied to modify its 2 GHz MSS authorization to add a second satellite at 115 WL. ICO's initial authorization is for 91 WL, with a pending request to change to 93 WL.
125.05 WL	Galaxy 14	The FCC approved PanAmSat's request to operate the Galaxy 14 satellite from 125.05 WL.
125.15 WL	Galaxy 12	The FCC approved PanAmSat's request to operate the Galaxy 12 satellite from 125.15 WL.
170 WL	AMC-23	The FCC granted SES Americom's request to test its AMC-23 satellite at 170 WL for up to 4 months following launch in December 2005. The C/Ku/Extended Ku-band satellite will replace the Satcom SN-4 satellite at 188 WL (172 EL).
