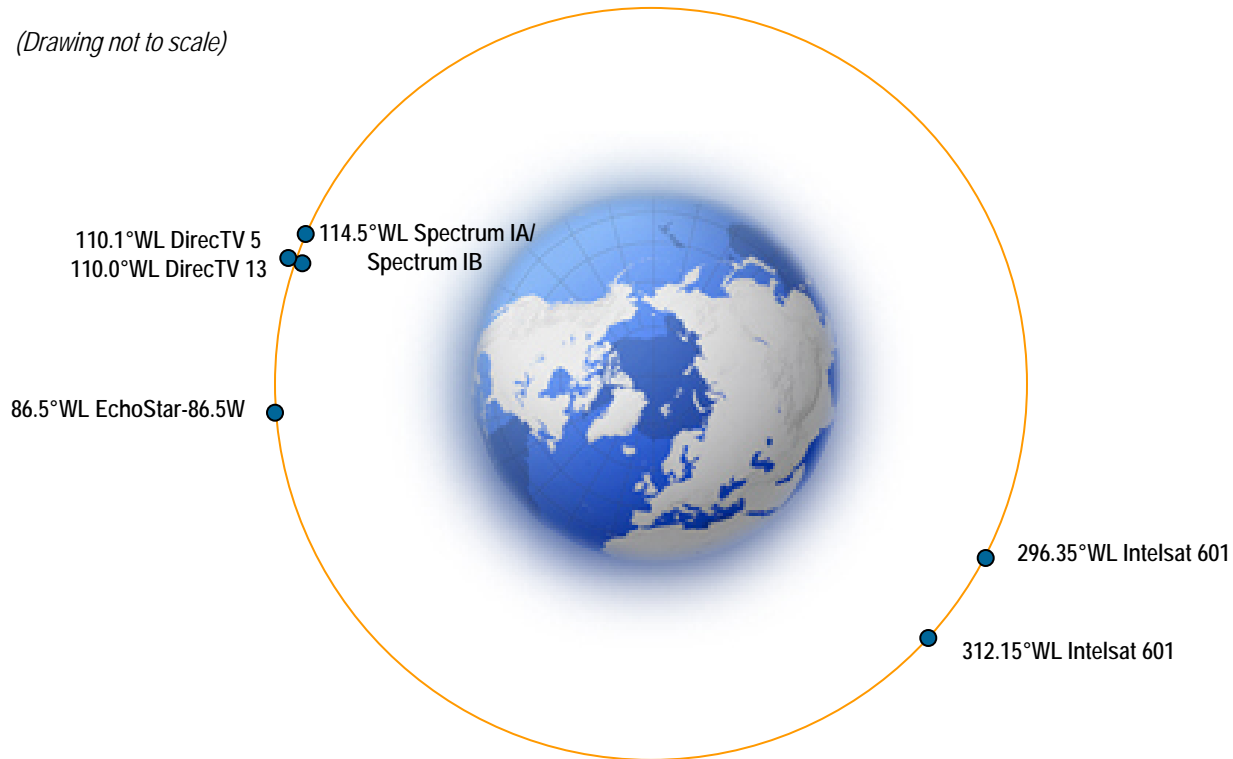


Satellite Regulatory Report

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for November 2006 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)		
Location	Satellite	Activity
86.5 WL	EchoStar-86.5W	The FCC granted EchoStar's request to construct a DBS satellite at 86.5 WL.
110 WL	DirecTV 13	The FCC granted DirecTV's request to launch and operate the DirecTV 13 satellite to replace DirecTV 5 at 110 WL.
110.1 WL	DirecTV 5	The FCC granted DirecTV's request to move the DirecTV 5 satellite from 109.8 WL to 110.1 WL.
114.5 WL	Spectrum IA, Spectrum IB	The FCC granted Spectrum Five's request to provide DBS service to the United States via Spectrum IA and Spectrum IB, two "short-spaced" foreign-licensed satellites located at 114.5 WL.
296.35 WL	Intelsat 601	The FCC granted Intelsat's request to move the Intelsat 601 satellite from 295.85 WL to 296.35 WL.
312.5 WL	Intelsat 601	Intelsat applied for 60-day temporary authority to drift the Intelsat 601 satellite to 312.5 WL (47.5 EL) from its current location at 296.35 WL (63.65 EL).
