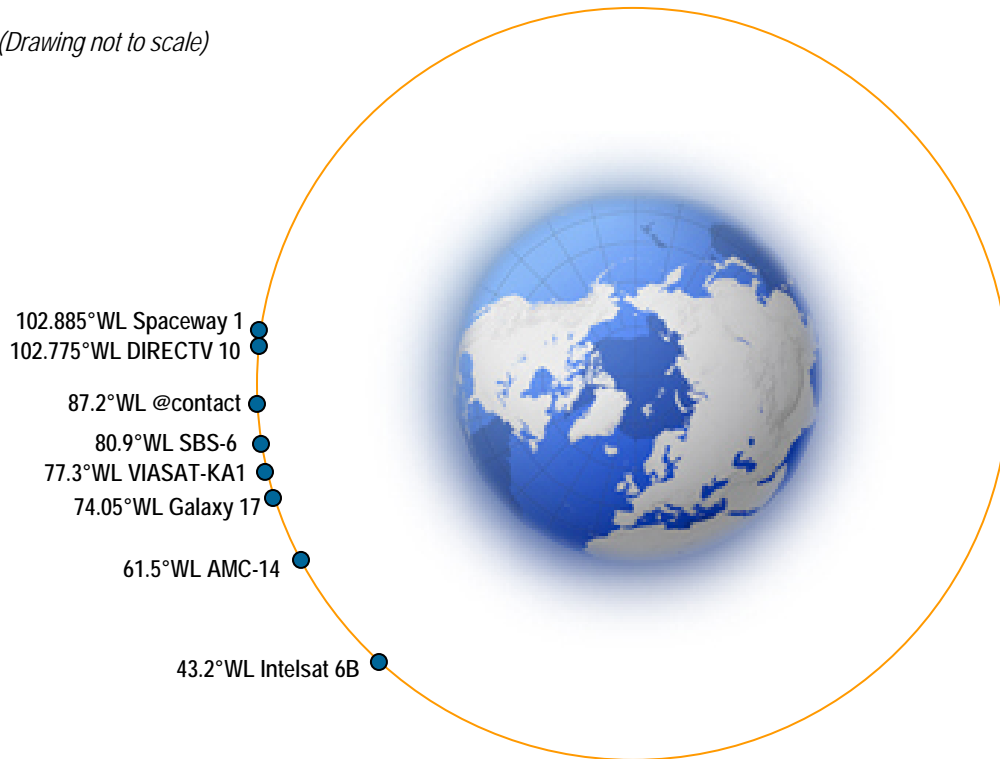

Location	Satellite	Activity
43.2 WL	Intelsat 6B	The FCC granted PanAmSat's request to move Intelsat 6B from 43.1 WL to 43.2 WL for a period of 180 days starting January 1, 2008.
61.5 WL	AMC-14	EchoStar applied to launch and operate AMC-14 at 61.5 WL.
74.05 WL	Galaxy 17	PanAmSat applied to move Galaxy 17 from 75.5 WL to 74.05 WL for another 30 days until January 23, 2008.
77.3 WL	VIASAT-KA1	ViaSat applied to modify its authority to operate VIASAT-KA1 at 77.3 WL.
80.9 WL	SBS-6	PanAmSat applied to relocate SBS-6 from 73.95 WL to 80.9 WL and to operate at the new location in accordance with the Argentine administration's Ku-band ITU filings.
87.2 WL	@contact	@contact applied to change the authorized orbital location of its Ka-band license from 83 WL to 87.2 WL.
102.775WL	DIRECTV 10	The FCC granted DIRECTV's request to modify its authority to operate DIRECTV 10 from 102.8 WL to 102.775 WL.
102.885 WL	Spaceway 1	The FCC granted DIRECTV's request to change its authorized location for Spaceway 1 from 102.8 WL to 102.885 WL.
