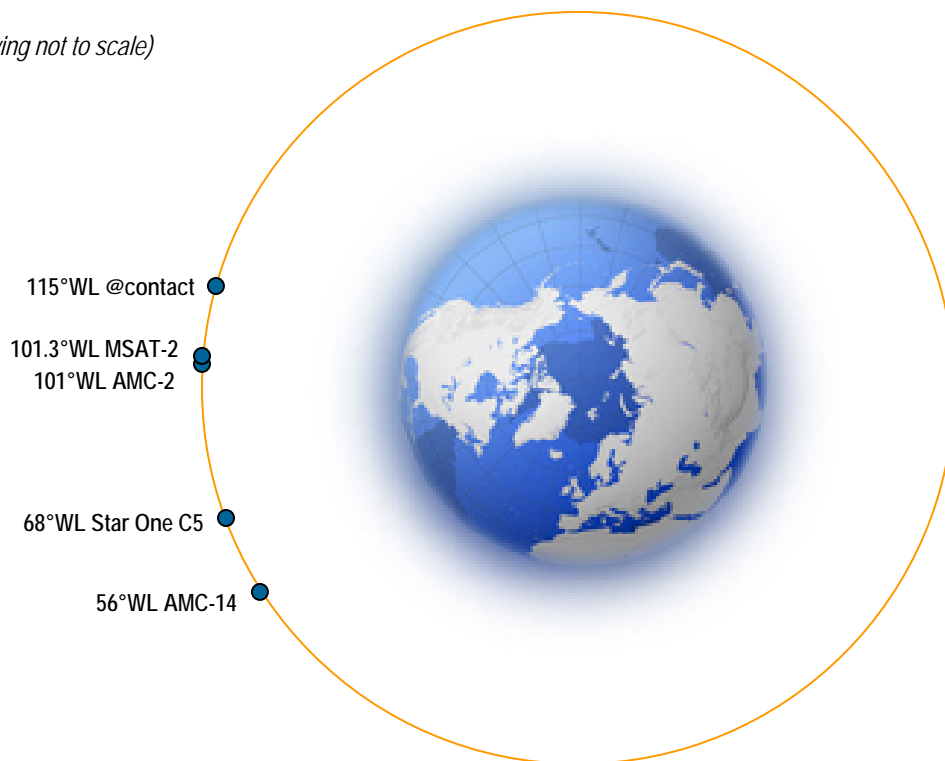

Description of Selected Regulatory Activity for February 2008 (derived from Futron's FCCFilings.com service)		
Location	Satellite	Activity
56 WL	AMC-14	EchoStar applied to launch and test AMC-14 at 56 WL for a period of 60 days, pending its authorization to launch and operate at 61.5 WL. The satellite is scheduled to launch in mid-March 2008.
68 WL	Star One C5	The FCC granted Star One's request to add Star One C5 to the FCC's Permitted Space Station List at 68 WL.
101 WL	AMC-2	The FCC granted SES Americom's request to relocate and operate AMC-2 from 85 WL to 101 WL for a period of 60 days, starting February 22, 2008.
101.3 WL	MSAT-2	The FCC granted MSV's request to move MSAT-2 from 100.95 WL to 101.3 WL for a period of 60 days, starting February 28, 2008.
115 WL	@contact	@contact applied to modify its authorized orbital location for its Ka-band license to 115 WL, instead of 121 WL.
